

## **USBS USED TO HELP FUTURE TECHNICIANS FIX BUSES**

Precision Wire Supply, LLC, of Indiana, has one job it does very well.

The company makes custom wire harnesses for bus manufacturers. Their work is so specialized, they don't even have a website or advertise in the phone book because customers come directly to them. They rely on their reputation of being the best to bring in new clients.

But, when that bus is delivered to its final owner, it comes with a USB drive loaded with a complete schematic of where the vehicle's electric boards are and how to access them. All the data needed for electrical repairs is also included on the unbranded drive.

"It is basically a schematic of where electrics are ran in the bus so if you have to access it for repair you know where to take the panel off, so you don't have to rip the whole thing apart. It also shows how it is connected to the power center," said Katie Evans, who orders USBs for the company.

Precision Wire Supply has seen demand for its parts increase, and has increased the frequency of its USB orders to match. Because the USB drives contain so much information, they've also needed to increase the memory capacity to ensure every part and possible repair is accounted for.
